<b>2.</b>	<b>Clause-2 Payment of price of Tender Documents</b>	The bidder submitting application for participation in the tender process shall require to make the payment of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) +GST @ 18% totally Rs. 11,800/- only through Demand Draft, drawn in favour of GRIDCO Limited.	The bidder submitting application for participation in the tender process shall require to make the payment of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) +GST @ 18% totally Rs. 11,800/- only <b>per bidder</b> , through Demand Draft, drawn in favour of GRIDCO Limited. In case of a trading licensee, the tender document fees shall be deposited per CGP on behalf of which the trading licensee is participating in the tender.
<b>3.</b>	<b>Clause-15 Billing Cycle</b>	The seller shall raise bills on monthly basis	The seller shall raise provisional bills on weekly basis i.e From 00:00 hrs of 1st day to 24:00 hrs of 8th day; From 00:00 hrs of 9th day to 24:00 hrs of 15th day; From 00:00 hrs of 16th day to 24:00 hrs of 23rd day; From 00:00 hrs of 24th day to 24:00 hrs of the last day of the respective month and final bill shall be raised after publication of SEA by SLDC, Odisha.
<b>4.</b>	<b>Clause-17 Deviation Settlement Mechanism (DSM)</b>	Deviation Settlement Mechanism (DSM) Regulations, 2024 of CERC as amended from time to time or OERC DSM Regulations to be implanted within the contract period shall be applicable mutatis mutandis.	Deviation Settlement Mechanism (DSM) Regulations, 2024 of CERC as amended from time to time (in absence of Intra State DSM regulations) or OERC DSM Regulations (after notification by OERC), if implemented within the contract period shall be applicable for under injection by seller w.r.t. its approved injection schedule. For excess injection w.r.t approved injection schedule shall be treated as inadvertent power, for which, GRIDCO is not liable to pay any price.



5.	Additional Clause	Payment Security Mechanism (PSM)	GRIDCO shall provide revolving Letter of Credit (LC) equivalent to 100% of the weekly energy corresponding to Contracted Capacity at the tariff indicated in PSA. LC shall be opened prior to commencement of supply of power.
6.	Additional Clause	Deviation to contracted capacity	Both the parties would ensure that actual scheduling does not deviate by more than 15% of the contracted power as per the approved open access on monthly (requisition) basis. In case downward deviation from Procurer side is more than 15% of contracted energy for which open access has been allocated on monthly basis, Procurer shall pay compensation at 20% of Tariff per kWh for the quantum of shortfall in excess of permitted deviation of 15% while continuing to pay open access charges as per the contract. In case deviation from Seller side is more than 15% of contracted energy for which open access has been allocated on monthly basis, Seller shall pay compensation to Procurer at 20% of Tariff per kWh for the quantum of shortfall in excess of permitted deviation of 15% in the energy supplied and pay for the open access charges to the extent not availed by the Procurer
